

PILLARS OF MIMIMUM STANDARDS

As an International Organization we strive to become the most respected Fraternity in the world. To become the most respected chapter on your campus you must set yourselves to a high standard and strive to reach that standard in everything you do. The asset of a strong Fraternity is the quality of membership. Therefore, these art the minimum expectations of every brother of the Sigma Alpha Mu Fraternity

Academics

Each frater must maintain a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) at or above the all-men's average at his campus. If any frater fails to meet these requirements he will be given one term to raise the level of his performance to these standards.

Attendance

Each frater must attend at least two social events hosted by the Fraternity in each semester. At least one of these social events must be a "brotherhood" event.

Each frater must attend at least seventy-five percent of the chapter meeting during each semester or social restrictions may be enforced.

Each frater must have his Fraternity dues to the Exchequer on time or he will be penalized in an amount determined by the Council.

Philanthropy

Each frater must complete a total of twenty hours of Community Service each term. Five of these hours must be completed in conjunction with a fraternal-wide philanthropic event. For every hour not completed by the individual, he will be fined an amount determined by the Council. Each brother must attend at least one philanthropic event sponsored or organized by the Fraternity.

Recruitment

Each frater must be present at a minimum of four recruitment events during the formal recruitment period. Each brother must attend at least one of the showcasing events to meet prospective candidates. Each frater must make a concerted effort to meet prospective candidates at all times.

Risk Management

Each frater must become familiar with the Risk Management Policy of the Sigma Alpha Mu. He is expected to abide by this policy at all time. Each frater is expected to become familiar with the University Alcohol Policy or subsequent policy on alcohol at group events. As a member of the Fraternity, he must abide by these rules on the campus of the University.

Each frater must be respectful of the fraternity property as well as the property of the brothers living in the chapter house. Any damage caused to the property of the Fraternity or to the property of the fraters living in the chapter result will result in a fine, replacement of the property by the individual, and possible social probation as see fit by the Executive Board of the Fraternity.

Brotherhood

Every frater in Sigma Alpha Mu Fraternity will regard his Fraternity and Fraters with the utmost respect. Each frater is expected to act as a representative of the chapter and of the Sigma Alpha Mu Fraternity on and off campus.
